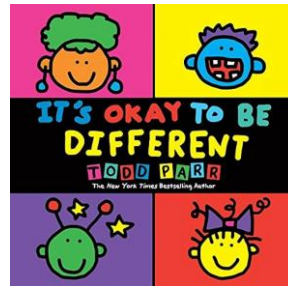
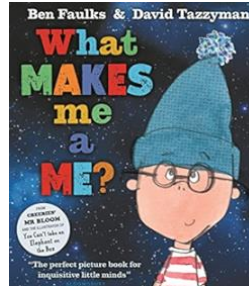
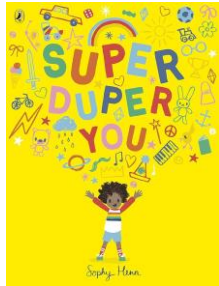




Mulberry News

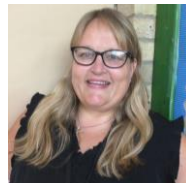
Your teachers are:
