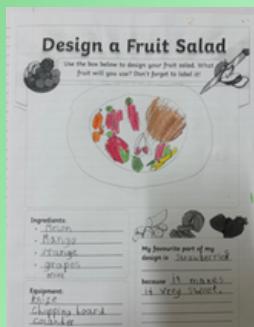


Reception
