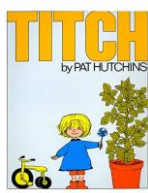
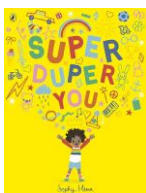
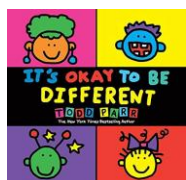
Welcome to St. Peter's C of E Primary School! We hope you all had a lovely summer!

OUR TOPICS THIS TERM ARE:

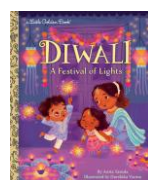
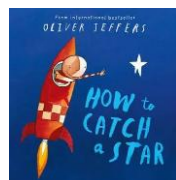
Autumn 1 – 'Marvellous Me'

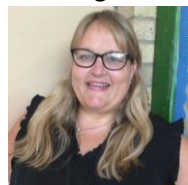
Your teachers are:
